

Rules Change Proposal - "Reweighing"

Background

Currently it is illegal to officially reweigh, if the boat touched water within the last two weeks before.

However an approved measurer can always check and make sure, that the boat is in a sufficiently dry condition for reweighing.

This procedure was tested successfully at the last worlds in Varberg/SWE with good experiences.

Target **allow reweighing in dry condition without requirement of 2-weeks drying**

5.8.5 Boats may be reweighed at any time by an approved Measurer providing that the boat is in dry condition. immediately prior to re-weighing, the boat has not touched water for a period of at least two weeks. The sailing weight and the number and weight of corrector weights Any modification of corrector weights of rules B - 5.8.3 and B - 5.8.4 shall be recorded updated on the certificate by the Measurer. ~~The corrector weights referred to in Rule B-5.8.3 may only be removed or reduced at a reweighing commissioned by the Owner under this paragraph and such reweighing may only take place at intervals greater than 12 months.~~
